• It is mandatory to submit abstract and full text with tables, graphs & images together for prize paper category

via separate links provided.

- Last date for abstract and full text submission 10th October 2023 (till midnight).
- Date of announcement of shortlisted papers for prize category yet to announce.
- Submission of abstracts along with full text must follow the guidelines listed by the scientific committee.
- Abstracts and full texts that are not selected for prize paper category will be moved to free paper category.

GuidelinesforAbstract

- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official congress book / JMOS supplement edition.
- Your abstract text should be no more than 500 words, including references.
- There is to be a maximum of two key references.
- Use standard abbreviations only. Within the body of the abstract, when using abbreviations spell out thename in full
- at the first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parenthesis. Abbreviations may be used in the title,

provided the name in full is outlined in the body of the abstract.

• Your abstract should follow the following structure where applicable: background, research aims/objectives, methods, results/findings and conclusions.

GuidelinesforPrizePaperSubmission

Abstractsubmissionforprizepapertobedonevialinkprovided

- Title-shouldbeaccurateandconcise, notexceeding 15 words.
 The abstract must be in IMRD (Introduction, Methodology, Research & Discussion) format (maximum wordli mit=500 words, fontstyle-Times New Roman-14)
- Introductionshoulddescribetheimplicationsandrationalebehindthestudy/technique,controversiesorgapsinexis tingknowledgecanbedescribedtodefendthestudy objectives.
- **AimsandObjectives**-shouldbespecificandachievable; should give a clear notion of what is to be described, determined, identified, compared and confirmed.
- MaterialandMethods-shouldincludeanin-depth description ofhow thestudywascarriedoutincludingstudy design, sample size and selection criteria, data collection, statistical analysis and ethicalconsiderations.
- **Results**-shouldsummarize the observations supplemented by tables / figures.
- **Discussion**-shouldprovideinterpretationoftheresultsandbesupportedwithappropriatereferences.

ManuscriptGuidelines

- ManuscriptshouldbeinwordformatpreferablyTimesNewRomanfontofsize12withdouble spacing.
- Themanuscriptshouldnotbelongerthan 2500 words excluding references.
- Totalnumberofreferencesshouldnotexceedbeyond25.
- Pictures, tablesorcharts(maximum4each)shouldbeincludedwhereverrequired.
- Graphsandimages—Themaximumfilesizeofeachgraph/imageis500KB.Themaximumpixelsize of the graph/image is 600(w) x 800(h) pixel. You may upload graphs in JPG, GIF or PNGformat.
