Prize Paper Category(Eligibility: Delegates Only)

- It is mandatory to submit abstract and full text with tables, graphs & images together for prize paper category via separate links provided.
- Last date for abstract and full text submission **10th October 2023 (till midnight)**.
- Date of announcement of shortlisted papers for prize category **yet to announce**.
- Submission of abstracts along with full text must follow the guidelines listed by the scientific committee.
- Abstracts and full texts that are not selected for prize paper category will be moved to free paper category.

GuidelinesforAbstract

- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official congress book / JMOS supplement edition.
- Your abstract text should be no more than 500 words, including references.
- There is to be a maximum of two key references.
- Use standard abbreviations only. Within the body of the abstract, when using abbreviations spell out the name in full at the first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parenthesis. Abbreviations may be used in the title, provided the name in full is outlined in the body of the abstract.
- Your abstract should follow the following structure where applicable: background, research aims/objectives, methods, results/findings and conclusions.

Guidelines for Prize Paper Submission

Abstract submission for prize paper to be done via link provided

- **Title**-should be accurate and concise, not exceeding 15 words.
The abstract must be in IMRD (Introduction, Methodology, Research & Discussion) format (maximum word limit=500 words, font style-Times New Roman-14)
- **Introduction**-
should describe the implications and rationale behind the study/technique, controversies or gaps in existing knowledge can be described to defend the study objectives.
- **Aims and Objectives**-should be specific and achievable; should give a clear notion of what is to be described, determined, identified, compared and confirmed.
- **Material and Methods**-should include an in-depth description of how the study was carried out including study design, sample size and selection criteria, data collection, statistical analysis and ethical considerations.
- **Results**-should summarize the observations supplemented by tables/figures.
- **Discussion**-should provide interpretation of the results and be supported with appropriate references.

- **Summaryandconclusions**

Manuscript Guidelines

- Manuscripts should be in word format preferably Times New Roman font of size 12 with double spacing.
- The manuscript should not be longer than 2500 words excluding references.
- Total number of references should not exceed beyond 25.
- Pictures, tables or charts (maximum 4 each) should be included wherever required.
- Graphs and images – The maximum file size of each graph/image is 500KB. The maximum pixel size of the graph/image is 600(w) x 800(h) pixel. You may upload graphs in JPG, GIF or PNG format.
